Agents uncover 9.6 million dollars in an oil drum

Agents have uncovered 9.6 million dollars in an oil drum they say was stashed by local cattle rustlers. The agents discovered a "false floor" in a horse stall at the Rocking L Ranch located in the Pilot Point area.
